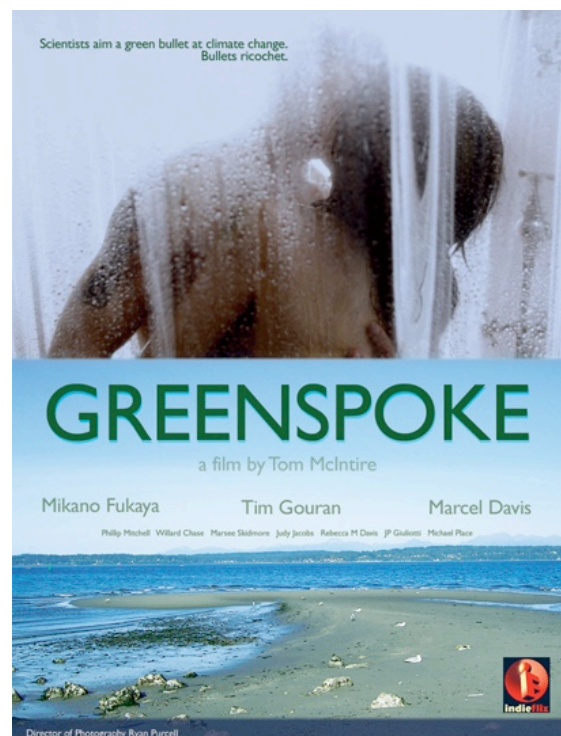
The film's themes and premise are just 15 minutes from now – genetically modified organisms, clean energy solutions and unintended environmental and personal consequences.

"I'm something of a science nerd and enjoyed using science that is possible now as the backbone of a story that is ultimately about the fragility of the connections between people, and between people and our environment."

Shot in, on and around Puget Sound, Greenspoke features a strong Seattle cast and stars Japanese actress Mikano Fukaya, Marcel Davis and Tim Gouran. Mikano will be attending the screenings and other cast members may be making an appearance at one or both screenings.
